### Union Cemetery Columbarium

The Pine Grove Mills Union Cemetery is located between Pine Grove Presbyterian Church and St. Alban's Anglican Church (formerly St. Paul Lutheran Church). The historic cemetery was started in 1832 and closed for in-ground burials in 1914. Many of the early members of our church, as well as community leaders, are buried in Union Cemetery.

A number of years ago, several individuals asked about the possibility of placing a columbarium on the grounds. In 2016, a 16-niche granite structure was added to the cemetery in response to the requests. The columbarium is on the western side of the patio in the back of the cemetery.

Six of the original niches are now available for purchase. A niche holds the cremains of one or two individuals. If you or someone you know would like to have more information about the columbarium, please contact Carol Zeigler (814-238-2213 or [bzncz@comcast.net](mailto:bzncz@comcast.net)).
